Supervisor Morse called the meeting to order at 2:00 P.M. Krzycki, Arney, Bobalik and Hovarter were present. Gary Bland, Zoning Administrator, and Dale Hutson, Assessor were also present.

The agenda was accepted as printed.

ASSESSOR'S REPORT: Hutson turned in the minutes for the December and March Board of Review. He also submitted the 2010 assessment roll.

ZONING ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT: Bland issued a permit for temporary housing to the Wittenburg's on US12. Their house was destroyed by fire.

Larry & Tina Barnell are building a shed to the back of their property.

Sturgis Petroleum combined two parcels and are building an addition to their property.

Bland removed the stop work order on Cabinsag's house on Sunnyfield.

MINUTES: Motion by Arney to approve, seconded by Bobalik. Motion carried.

BILLS FOR PAYMENT: Motion by Bobalik to approve, seconded by Krzycki. Motion carried.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Motion by Hovarter to approve, seconded by Bobalik. Motion carried. Krzycki asked for board approval, and was granted, permission to have our attorney write a letter to Pitney-Bowles and Sprint regarding their overdue taxes.

OLD BUSINESS: Mike Oxender was present. Lester Butler and Tom Considine would like to buy his property and start a metal recycling business. Morse made a motion, seconded by Bobalik, to start the process but have a detailed business plan ready to submit next month.

Arney stated that the Fawn River Crossing brochures are done but they are very expensive so they will be handed out selectively.

NEW BUSINESS: Bobalik stated that our web site viewers are increasing. There were 293 viewers in 2009 and already 180 in 2010.

Morse suggested the PC consider an amendment to the ordinance concerning public utilities and their adherence to the ordinance concerning their control stations.
