STURGIS TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Morse at 7:00 P.M. Krzycki, Arney, Bobalik and Hovarter were present. Gary Bland, Zoning Administrator, and Dale Hutson, Assessor, were also present.

The agenda was accepted as printed.

Assessor's Report: Nothing to report.

Zoning Administrator's Report: Bland has been working with the Harley Davidson people on their Outdoor Assembly (Blessing of the Bikes).

Minutes: Approved with a motion by Arney, seconded by Bobalik.

Bills For Payment: Approved with a motion by Bobalik, seconded by Arney.

Treasurer's Report: Approved with a motion by Bobalik, seconded by Arney.

Old Business: Hovarter made a motion to rescind the motion made to approve the recycling business on White School road. Bobalik seconded. The matter must be reconsidered as approval was given before a public hearing was held.

New Business: Patti Clark was reappointed to the Sturgis District Library Board for another four year term with a motion by Morse, seconded by Bobalik.

Permission was granted to the VFW to parade down Nottawa Street on Memorial Day. Motion by Hovarter, seconded by Arney.

Hovarter made a motion to retain Norman & Paulsen to do the audit again. Arney seconded.

The Board voted unanimously not to participate in the Dam Days Parade.

Fire Report: The Department went on 309 calls this year. Down from 323 last year. Kulpinski would like the number of personnel increased to 20 or 22. He stated there is no need for a new truck (unless something unforeseen happens) for at least a year so Morse made a motion to lock in the fire truck fund for one year. He was seconded by Bobalik. The Dept. used the additional grant money for more radios.

Kulpinski has requested two new entry doors with card system locks and also a new overhead door. He also requested a new phone unit for the truck and new training gear. The assistant chief has been working with the Doyle center to create a training program for the Dept. personnel.
