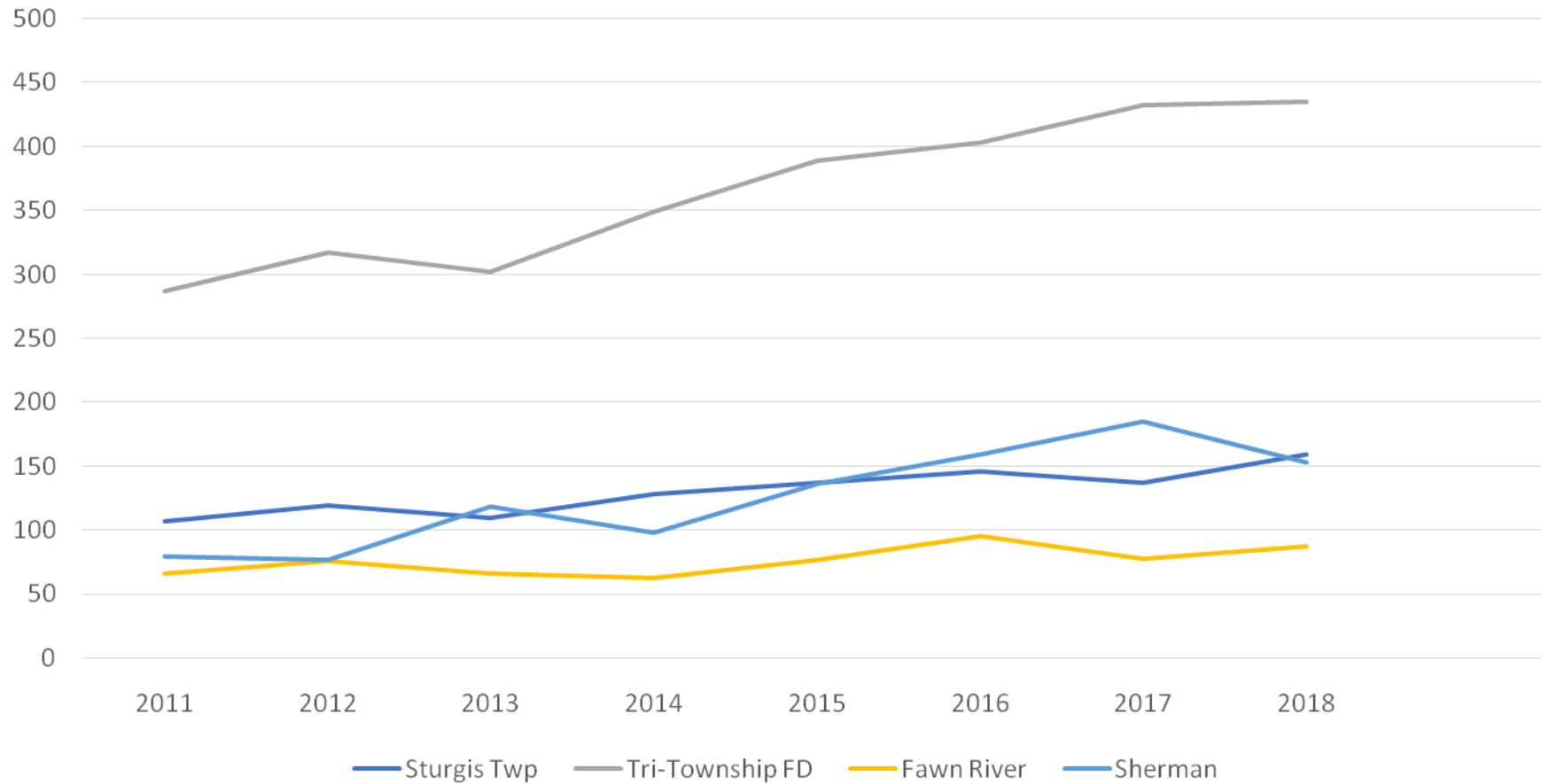
Service District

- Tri-Township Fire Department serves over 7,500 people in an 83 square mile district.
- Tri-Township Fire Department operates from 2 Stations
 - Station 6-1 (North)
 - Engine 6-11, Class A Pumper/Tanker, Licensed EMR Vehicle
 - Engine 6-21, Class A Pumper
 - Station 6-2 (Main)
 - Engine 6-12, Class A Rescue Engine, Licensed EMR Vehicle
 - Tanker 6-16, 3,500 gallon water transport
 - Brush 6-15, Brush Truck, Licensed EMR vehicle

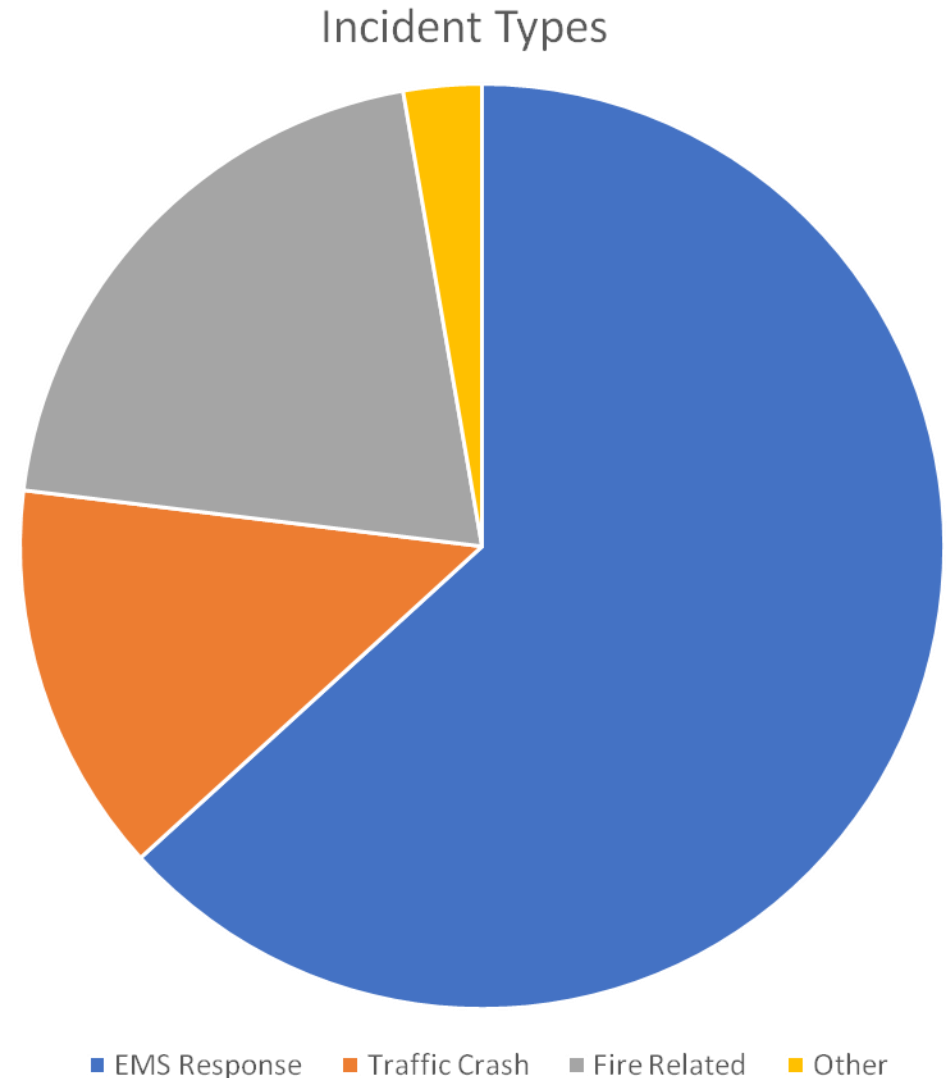

Call Volume Trends



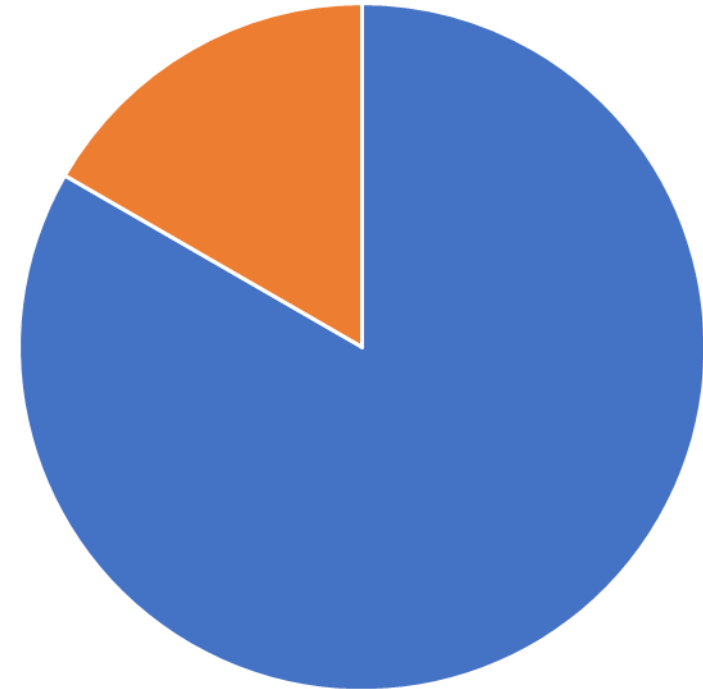
Incidents by Type during 2018

- 22 Mutual Aid Calls



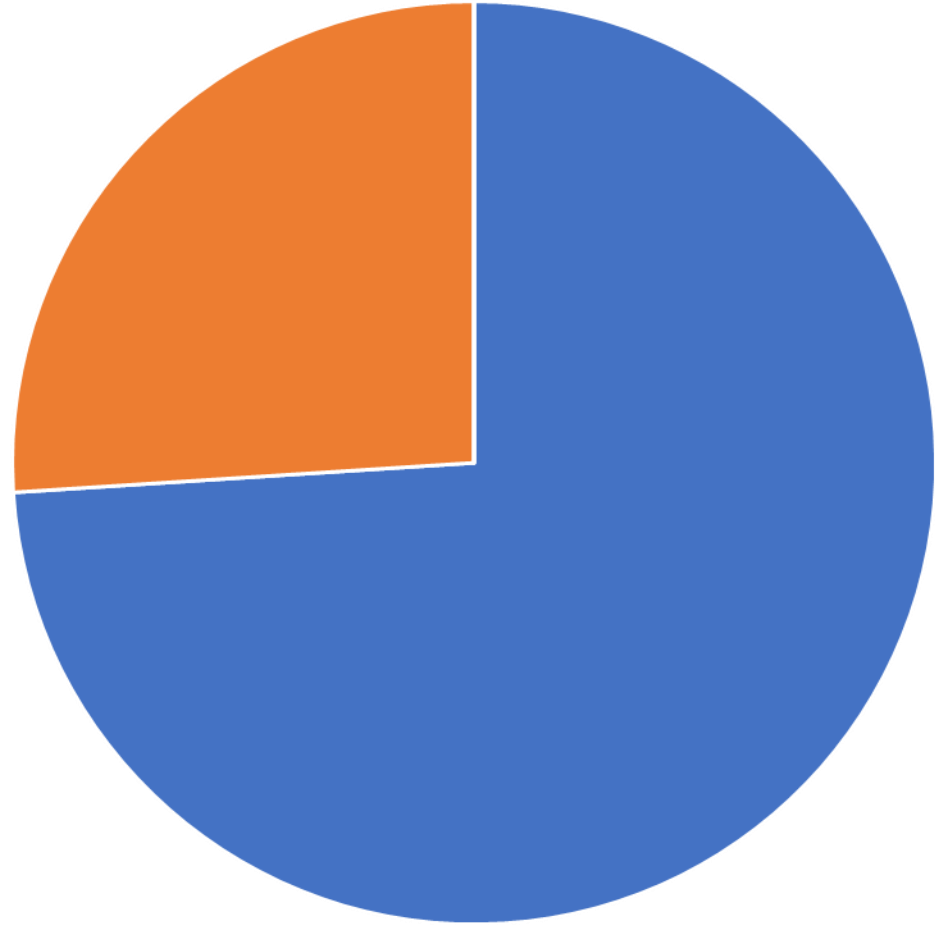
Call Volume in Fawn River Township

87 Incidents recorded in Fawn River Township up from 77 during 2017



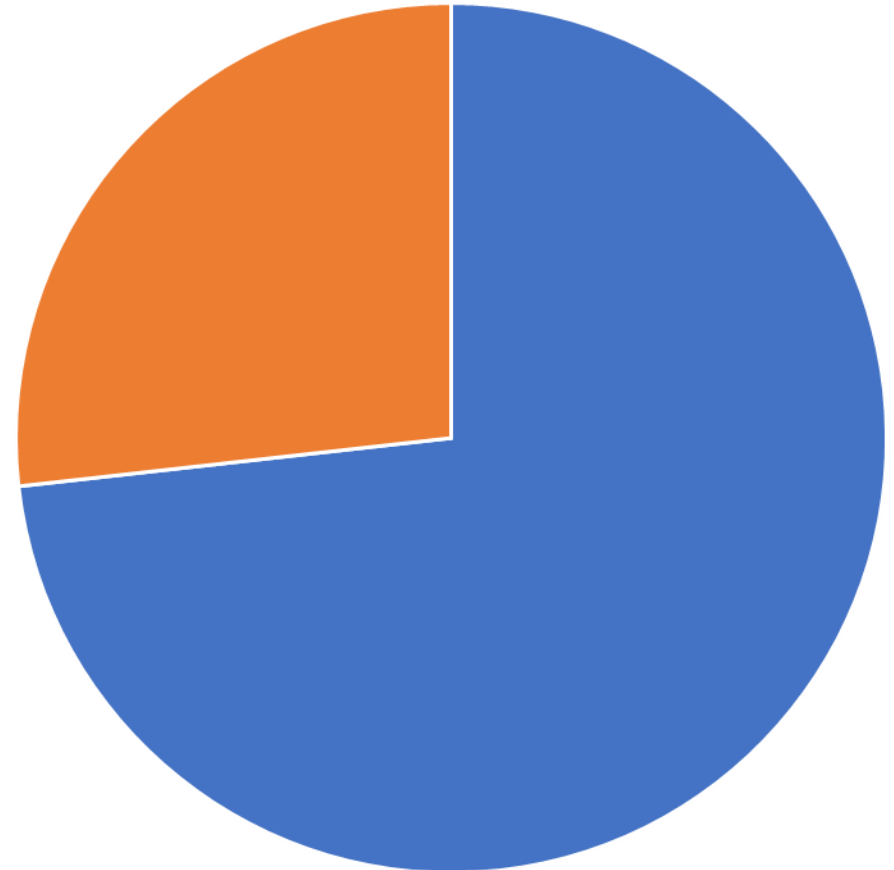
Incident in Sherman Township 2018
